

**Notice for Spot Counselling against seats to be filled by  
JEE-MAINS-2018 candidates  
(U.P. Domicile only)**

**Eligibility for Participation in Spot Counseling (Who can apply?)**

1. For B.TECH. candidature, the candidate should have passed 12th standard of U.P. Board or (10 + 2) examination from any other board with a minimum aggregate of 60% marks (55% in case of the candidates belonging to SC/ST category) in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics without grace in any of these subjects. In addition, candidate should have studied a minimum of five subjects (including the above three and English) in his /her qualifying examination. In addition, all other eligibility conditions for appearing in JEE (Mains) 2018 examination shall be applicable to the candidates.
2. Candidates who have either participated for online counselling process conducted by HBTU, Kanpur but failed to get a seat or withdrew his/her candidature from online counseling at any stage, may participate in the Spot Counselling process.
3. The JEE-MAIN-2018 candidates who have not participated/registered in online counselling conducted by HBTU, Kanpur may also participate in Spot Counselling process.
4. All the candidates have to deposit Rs. 2000/- (non-refundable) as registration fee in the form of DD/Cash. The DD will be drawn in favor of Finance Controller, HBTU, Kanpur, Payable at Kanpur.
5. Seat Allotment Information regarding vacant seats in various courses will be published at University Website ([www.hbtu.ac.in](http://www.hbtu.ac.in)) latest by August 5, 2018. The vacant seats shall be allotted as per CRL (Common Rank List) rank only of the candidates present, in person, at HBTU Kanpur for spot counselling process.
6. The U.P. Domicile certificate (father/ mother) is mandatory only for the candidates who have passed qualifying examination (10+2) from other states other than U.P. only. Candidates who have passed qualifying examination (10+2) from U.P., need not to produce U.P. domicile certificate.

## **Process for Participation**

1. The interested and eligible candidate has to furnish the relevant information at the link <https://goo.gl/forms/CQyCwdBT3yLJCu9t2> provided on the University website.
2. All candidates willing to participate in spot counselling should report personally at **Harcourt Butler Technical University , Kanpur** on August 10, 2018 at 10 am. The candidates are required to report with all original documents with one set of self-attested Photostat copies of the same along with 5 copies of passport size photograph and printout of online submitted form (available at University website at link <https://goo.gl/forms/CQyCwdBT3yLJCu9t2> ) at HBTU, Kanpur
3. **The candidates are also required to bring a demand draft of Annual University Fee [Rs.15000./- and Rs. 98300/- separately (for Hostellers) & Rs. 98,300/- (for Non-Hostellers)] in the form of demand draft. The demand draft should be made in favor of Finance Controller, HBTU Kanpur payable at Kanpur.** In addition to it, the hosteller has to deposit Rs. 33000/- in cash, in the bank account of respective hostel which will be intimated at the time of counselling process.
4. The REGISTRATION for Spot Counselling is open from August 4, 2018 to August 8, 2018. All the vacant seat in spot counseling are unreserved.
5. There may be further rounds of SPOT COUNSELLING, if needed at HBTU Kanpur.
6. Please note that
  - a. After seat allotment (if offered), the candidate has to immediately deposit Annual University Fee failing which the seat allotment shall be cancelled and the seat will be offered to the next available candidates as per his/her rank.
  - b. The candidates should come with bag & baggage as once the seat is allotted, they should attend the classes as per schedule.
  - c. The candidate who has already occupied the seat are not eligible for spot counseling
  - d. The link/detail for vacant seat is available on university website [www.hbtu.ac.in](http://www.hbtu.ac.in) for other details. For other details, the candidates are

required to visit university website and information brochure of the university.
