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was reported by the Calcutta High Court at 11,417, followed by the Bombay High Court (3,901), Patna High Court (3,513), Madras High Court (3,118) and Rajasthan High Court (2,111). However, each of these courts trails Allahabad by a wide margin.

Overall, the high courts had 6.47 million pending cases as on July 16. Of these, 452,000 had been pending for more than 20 years, 1.61 million for over 10 years, 2.97 million for over five years and 5.24 million for more than a year.

Responding to a question in the Rajya Sabha, Meghwal reiterated that pendency arises from multiple factors, including the complexity of cases, nature of evidence and cooperation of stakeholders such as lawyers, investigating agencies, witnesses and litigants.

against Mann in a 2020 violent protest case.

Issuing notice to Mann and others who are named as accused in the case, a bench headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI) Surya Kant said, "We will issue notice. This requires examining."

The Chandigarh administration had challenged the November 29, 2025 order of the Punjab and Haryana high court exonerating Mann and other in the case.

The high court quashed the criminal case registered against Mann and others in January 2020 for protesting outside the then CM's house during which some police personnel were allegedly injured.

The selected Patent Attorney / Registered Patent Agent shall assist the University in handling patent and IPR-related matters including, but not limited to, prior-art search, patentability assessment, drafting, filing, prosecution, IP portfolio management, commercialization advisory, and legal representation before relevant authorities.

The empanelment aims to strengthen the University’s innovation ecosystem by ensuring timely protection, prosecution, and strategic management of intellectual property generated within the institution.

1. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Engagement shall be purely on a **contractual / retainer basis** and shall not constitute regular employment with the University.
2. The empanelment shall be non-exclusive, and the University reserves the right to empanel multiple attorneys / firms based on requirements.

3. The selected attorney shall provide professional services for patent, copyright, trademark, design, and other IPR-related matters as assigned by the University.
4. The University reserves the right to accept or reject any application without assigning reasons.
5. Submission of application does not guarantee empanelment.
6. The University may amend, modify, or withdraw this empanelment notice at any stage.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must satisfy the following minimum eligibility requirements:

Mandatory Qualifications

1. Must be a **Registered Patent Agent** under the relevant provisions of the Patents Act or a qualified Patent Attorney authorized to practice in India.
2. Must possess a valid registration certificate and be in good professional standing.
3. Minimum **5 years of proven professional experience** in patent drafting, filing, prosecution, and IPR advisory services.

Experience Requirements

The applicant should have:

1. Successfully handled at least **50 granted patents**.
2. Demonstrated experience in **drafting provisional and complete patent specifications**.
3. Proven experience in **patent prosecution**, including responses to examination reports and hearings.
4. Experience in **national and international patent filing**, including:
 - i. Indian patent filings
 - ii. Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) application
 - iii. National phase filings in foreign jurisdictions
5. Prior experience working with universities, R&D institutions, incubators, start-ups, or research organizations shall be preferred.
6. Experience in handling inventions from interdisciplinary domains such as engineering, agriculture, biotechnology, food technology, pharmaceuticals, medical devices, AI, and allied sciences shall be desirable.
