MARTYRS' DAY

DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF CHANDRASHEKHAR AZAD

"Azad hi rahein hain, azad hi rahenge"

On the occasion of Chandra Shekhar Azad Jayanti, NSS HBTU conducted an event in which everyone pay homage to the brave freedom fighter.

Born on 23 July 1906 in Bhavra village, Jhabua district Madhya Pradesh, he went to Varanasi for higher studies and subsequently became fascinated and was drawn towards the national upsurge of the non-violent and non-cooperation movement under the leadership of Mahatma Gandhi.

It is said that at Alfred Park the freedom fighter managed to keep the police at bay single-handedly with a small pistol and a few cartridges. However, left with a single bullet he shot himself in the head rather than being arrested and dragged to the gallows to be hanged.

Chandra Shekhar Azad died on 27 February 1931 in Alfred Park, Allahabad after an associate betrayed him to the British.

In the end "The team members of NSS pay their heartfelt tributes to revolutionary freedom fighter Chandra Shekhar Azad. With the combined support of our faculty and students and the combined efforts of our volunteers we collected an estimate of Rs. 18, 00,000/- from online and offline sources.

Children, by will or by force are employed to work in the harsh conditions and atmosphere which becomes a threat to their life. Child Labour leads to underdevelopment, incomplete mental and physical development, which in turn drastically affects the growth of children.

International Labour Organization (ILO) defines the term child labour as, "work that deprives children of their childhood, their potential and their dignity, and that is harmful to physical and mental development. It refers to work that is mental, physically, socially or morally dangerous and harmful to children, or work whose schedule interferes with their ability to attend regular school or work that affects in any manner their ability to focus during school or experience a healthy childhood.

The day is celebrated because it's necessary to make people aware.

LECTURE ON NOBLE PRIZE WINNER C V RAMAN AND EXHIBITION BY **HBTU STUDENTS**

He then observed a change in wavelength after light passed through ice cubes.
