EDUCATE POOR CHILDREN

Team NSS HBTU, KANPUR organised a program on Educate poor children on 2 June, 2022. The main objective of this programme was to create awareness about education for poor children.

Team 'Saakshar' began with teaching children of the non-teaching staff of the college. This project aims to enable the holistic development of underprivileged students by imparting quality education free of cost. 

With the combined support of our faculty and students and the combined efforts of our volunteers we collected an estimate of Rs. 18, 00,000/- from online and offline sources.

CANDLE MARCH FOR PULWAMA MARTYRS AND DONATION OF ONE DAY SALARY OF FACULTY AND STAFF

The heart-breaking moment was faced by our entire nation when 44 soldiers were martyred in Pulwama attack. In honour of Indian soldiers who were martyred during the Pulwama Attack by terrorist in Kashmir, the students and faculty of HBTU organised the peaceful Candle March within the College Premises. DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF CHANDRASHEKHAR AZAD

"Azad hi rahein hain, azad hi rahenge"

On the occasion of Chandra Shekhar Azad Jayanti, NSS HBTU conducted an event in which everyone pay homage to the brave freedom fighter.

Born on 23 July 1906 in Bhavra village, Jhabua district Madhya Pradesh, he went to Varanasi for higher studies and subsequently became fascinated and was drawn towards the national upsurge of the non-violent and non-cooperation movement under the leadership of Mahatma Gandhi.

It is said that at Alfred Park the freedom fighter managed to keep the police at bay single-handedly with a small pistol and a few cartridges. However, left with a single bullet he shot himself in the head rather than being arrested and dragged to the gallows to be hanged.

Chandra Shekhar Azad died on 27 February 1931 in Alfred Park, Allahabad after an associate betrayed him to the British.

In the end " The team members of NSS pay their heartfelt tributes to revolutionary freedom fighter Chandra Shekhar Azad. His unwavering devotion, undeterred determination & ultimate sacrifice for our motherland has inspired many generations and will inspire our future generations as well. Inquilab Zindabad!".
