GMAT TALK

GMAT talk was conducted on January 17, 2019 by Mr. Prateek Baghel, an alumnus of HBTU, Kanpur who has graduated in Electronics engineering in 2013. Mr. Baghel has done MBA and MMA from Smith School of Business at Queen's University. Giving brief introduction about GMAT exam, Mr. Baghel told us that GMAT is quite different from conventional exams like GRE, Civil Services, etc. Doing MBA from a good B school gives a global recognition. GMAT is held 5 times a year and the score valid for 5 years. The exam is 3 hours and 7 minutes and contains 4 sections of analytical writing assessment(AWR), integrated reasoning(IR), quantitative reasoning(QR), verbal reasoning(VR).

The score range is 200-800 where score of 780 and above correspond to 100 percentile. He suggested some preparatory books like GMAT Original Guide, Kaplan GMAT material, Manhattan GMAT material and added that 300 hours is sufficient for preparation.



Of the priceless tips he gave, one was to have a good LinkedIn profile and have large connection of people on it. He remarked that one must send the LinkedIn request along with message.

He concluded the oration with a very important piece of career advice. He said that in India people focus more on grade unlike western countries which focus on one's soft skills and his attitude towards the work. He said, "no one cares about grades, if you are in good B school it means you are academically good, so be good on soft skills."

The audience was very grateful to Mr. Baghel for he not only shared valuable preparation tips for GMAT but also highlighted its overwhelming benefits for engineering graduates.

He said that the main ambiguity occurs after you secure a good percentile and sit for the selection in some renowned B-school. For this he suggested following criteria to judge a school on

1. Ranking
2. Culture of school i.e. team culture, various extracurricular activities etc
3. Expenditure – if expenses are too high then seek for that school which provides good scholarship
4. Location- Harvard and Yale are best B-schools in this respect. A very important point that he mentioned was one must think twice before joining any B-school in the USA because of its inconsistent policies.
