General Conditions

a) In institutions /universities where a division/class is not awarded, the candidate shall have to submit the relevant conversion formulae for proof of first division from their respective universities/institutes. If a division/class is not awarded, a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate shall be considered equivalent first class/division. If a Grade Point System is adopted the CGPA will be converted into equivalent marks as per the Table given below:

- b) The screening of applications shall be done based on the candidate's API calculated as per prescribed guidelines
- c) For the post of Assistant Professor, there will be a written test in the Chemistry discipline. The screening of applicants for the post of Assistant Professor shall be done on the basis of their combined API and the score in the written test.
- d) Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PH/EWS shall as per the UP-state government rules.
- e) In case of exceptional merit, the Selection Committee may recommend a maximum of 03 additional increments for higher qualifications, experience and achievements by the candidates
- f) Persons already in employment should apply through proper channel.
- g) As per the UGC Gazette Notification dated October 12th 2021, Ph.D Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor with effect from 01.07.2023.
