


(27 September, 2023)



It was told by Dr. Vikas Yadav, Secretary of Women's Studies Center HBTU, that to stay away from negative thinking in jail, make a daily chart and keep yourself busy in work from morning to evening. Keep them in mind and after coming out from here, start small works with the help of self-help groups so that women can become self-reliant and selfsufficient. For this, the university will provide support. The university's deputy registrar Professor Vandana Kaushik talked to women prisoners who are computer literate. They were told about various types of courses and in this regard, the university has tried to organize a training camp. The jail superintendent BD Pandey gave information about the jail manual etc. and jail discipline. (Yoga Camp and International Yoga Day, 15-21 June 2024)




