Notice for Offline Counselling for admission against vacant seats of B.Tech. programs 2021-22

1. The vacant seat position of I B.Tech Counselling alongwith seats vacant due to withdrawal of the admitted candidates will be filled through offline counselling and it is scheduled on November 30, 2021 in the University premises.
2. The schedule of offline counselling is as follows :

* Those candidates who have already paid Rs. 40000.00 in 4th round of counselling as participation fee, and no seat was allotted, they have to register online again to participate in the Offline counselling and need to deposit only Rs. 95000.00 in case seat is allotted.

Detailed Guidelines for Admission to B.Tech. Programs
at HBTU, Kanpur through Offline-in-Campus Counselling for Session 2021-22

1. Applications for admission to various B.Tech. programs at HBTU, Kanpur through Offline Counselling are invited for the session 2021-22 against vacant seats (after completion of Online Counselling) through Online Registration on through Google form link <https://forms.gle/BpmUZXHbmfNj8mj9> Admissions will be made on the basis of merit of **JEE (Main)-2021**. Detailed guidelines related to admission are available on University website *www.hbtu.ac.in*
2. Candidates are advised to read these guidelines carefully, check their eligibility and applicable category etc. before filling and submitting the Online Registration Form.
3. The University shall conduct its own Offline counselling on the basis of merit of **JEE (Mains) 2021** with following criteria :-
 - a) The admission in Offline Counselling is permitted only in General categories. Candidates belonging to Other category shall be treated as General category. Admission against all the vacant seat are unreserved seats and candidates belonging to all category may apply for it. Seats will be allotted on merit using Combined Rank List (CRL Rank) of JEE-Mains 2021.
 - b) The students already admitted in I B.Tech. program through Online Counselling are not allowed for Offline Counselling.
 - c) The candidate must have clearly passed (10 + 2) qualifying examination from U.P. Board or its equivalent from any other recognized Board / University with a minimum of five subjects in which **Physics and Mathematics are compulsory subjects** along with **one of the subjects** from **Chemistry / Biotechnology / Biology/Computer Science as Technical Vocational** subjects. Candidates must obtain at least 60% marks (55% for SC/ST candidates) in aggregate in above three subjects. In addition, all other eligibility conditions for appearing in JEE (Mains) -2021 Examination shall be applicable to the candidates.
 - d) The admission in the branches of Computer Science and Engineering, Electrical Engineering is permissible if the All India Rank (CRL) of the student is not below than the rank of the last candidate admitted in Open Category (General) in the 3rd round of Online Counselling.
4. (a) A Candidate who is a domicile of Uttar Pradesh, i.e. he / she has passed the 10+2 qualifying examination from Institution located in U.P., is eligible for counselling.
(b) In case, the candidate has passed qualifying examination from outside U.P., he / she has to upload Permanent Residence Certificate of his / her parents (Father or Mother).
(c) Candidates who are wards of Defence Personnel settled or posted in UP on the date of Entrance Examination of **JEE (Mains) 2021** or Officers /Employees of All

India Services belonging to UP Cadre are also eligible. They are required to upload Certificate No. 10 to claim the benefit.

5. Accepting admission in HBTU Kanpur implies the acceptance by the candidate and his / her parents or guardians of all the terms and conditions laid down by the University. Any change in the rules, regulations, fee and other specific conditions etc. of the University shall apply mutatis mutandis to the admitted candidates.
6. The candidates for whom the result of the qualifying examination has not been declared till the date of Online registration due to any reason, whatsoever, shall not be eligible for admission under any circumstances.
7. If any document / declaration submitted by the candidate is found to be false at any stage, his / her admission will be cancelled and he / she may be liable for prosecution under the law. In case of any legal dispute, the jurisdiction will be limited to Kanpur Court only.
8. The candidates must ensure their eligibility for admission to B.Tech. programs at HBTU Kanpur while applying. University will not be responsible for any error of judgement on the part of the candidate.

9. **Offline Counselling Procedure**

Tentative schedule of Offline Counselling, Procedure & Fee Deposition details are given below:

- a) Candidates have to register on Google form link provided by University by depositing Online Registration Fee of Rs. 2500=00 (non-refundable) during 28 Nov.-29 Nov., 2021 (upto 3:00pm)
 - b) The reporting time of Candidates in the University Auditorium is 10:00am – 12:00Noon on 30 Nov., 2021.
 - c) Candidates have to bring all listed documents in original and one set of self attested photocopy for verification on 03 Nov., 2021.
 - d) In case of Seat allotment and subsequent Document verification, the candidate has to submit of full academic fee of Rs. 1,35,000/- through Online/Cash & DD in favour of **Finance Controller, HBTU, Kanpur** payable at **Kanpur** on **30 Nov., 2021** at the specified counter in the University premises.
 - e) Those candidates who have already paid Rs. 40,000/- as participation fee in 4th round of Online counselling, and no seat was allotted, will deposit only Balance Fee Rs. 95,000/- instead of Rs. 1,35,000/-
10. In case, Board / University awards only letter grades for qualifying examination without providing an equivalent percentage of marks, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board / University specifying equivalent marks.
 11. The allotment of seats through counselling will be carried out strictly on merit in accordance with the JEE (Main) 2021 rank of the candidate subject to the order of

choice preference given for the seat and the availability of seats in the specified category.

12. All the information in connection with B.Tech. Admission 2021 shall be made available through the admission website: <http://www.hbtu.ac.in>. The candidates are advised to visit these websites regularly. University will not be responsible for any loss to candidate due to the lack of communication.

13. **Medical Standards**

a) Candidates will have to submit a certificate of Medical Fitness / Handicapped on Certificate no. 8.

b) The medical standards prescribed are given below:

Height	Candidates should be physically fit to pursue his / her studies in opted course.

Heart and lungs	No abnormality
Hernia, Hydrocele, Piles etc.	Presence of any of these is to be corrected before joining
Vision	Normal, if defective, it must be got corrected to 6/9 in the better eye and 6/12 in the worse one. Eyes should be free from congenital or any other disease
Hearing	Normal, If defective, it must be got corrected before joining.

Physically Handicapped / Disabled:

Physically Handicapped / Disabled persons of Uttar Pradesh will have a minimum of 5% reservation on the basis of impairment and mentioned below:

Type I	Minimum 40% permanent Visual impairment
Type II	Minimum 40% permanent Locomotors disability
Type III	Minimum 40% permanent speech and Hearing impairment

14. **Formats for various certificates to be uploaded (as applicable) for Online document Verification at the University.** All the formats of certificates are available on Admission Website www.hbtuadmission.nic.in and University website www.hbtu.ac.in.

15. The vacant seats shown in Table 1 are tentative and subjected to change based on request received from the withdrawal cases of admitted candidates.
