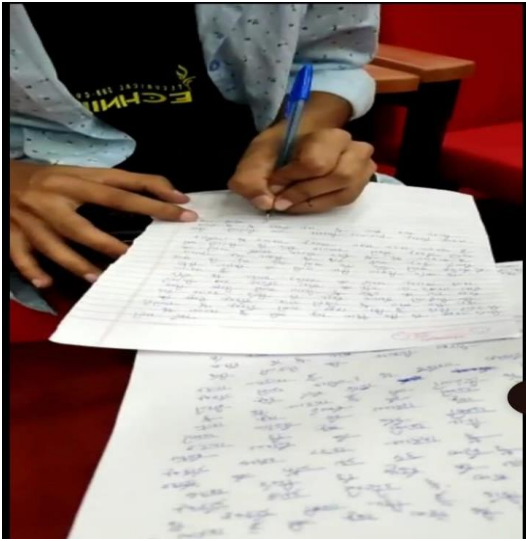

DEBATE-E-THON



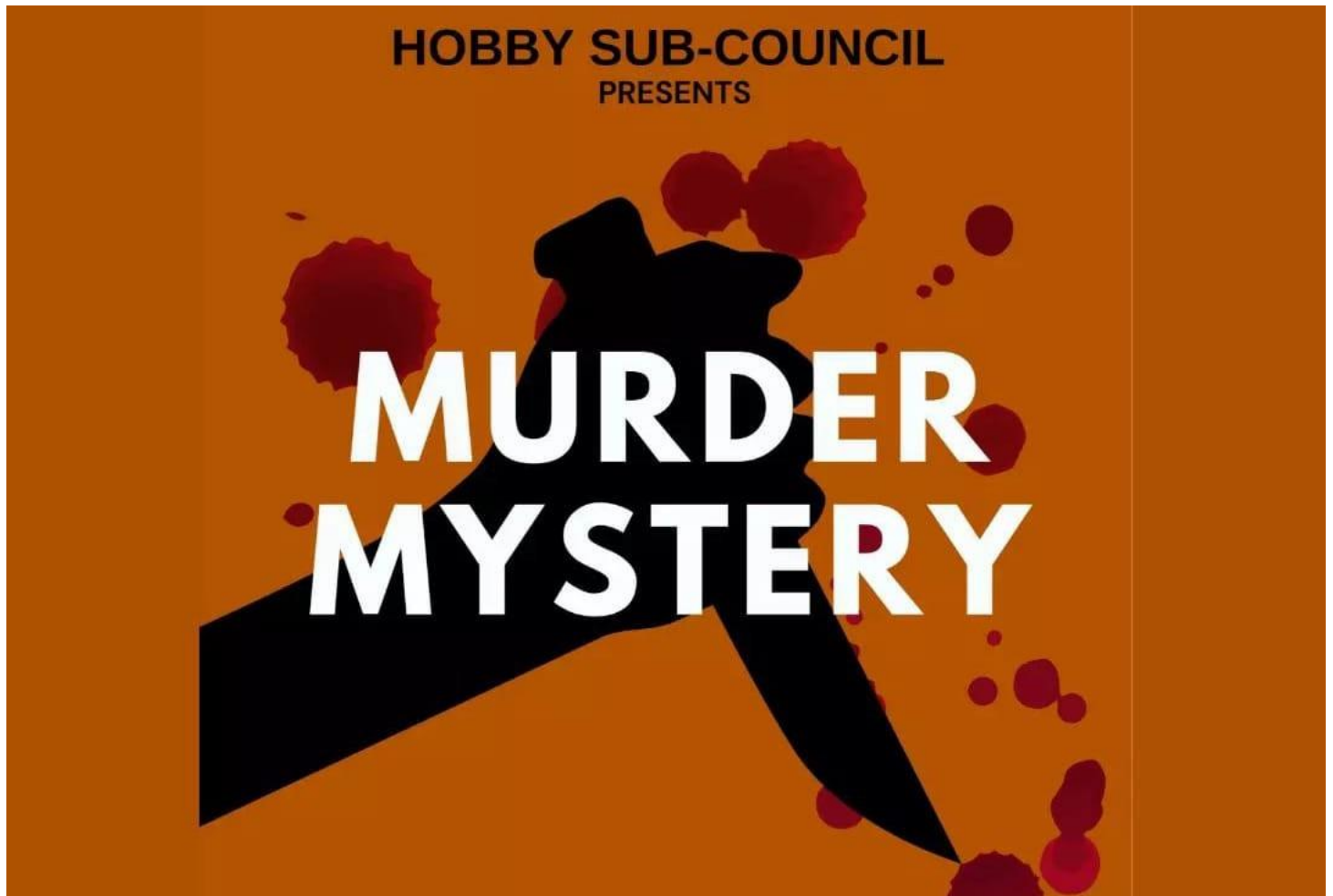

Electronic dance music night:

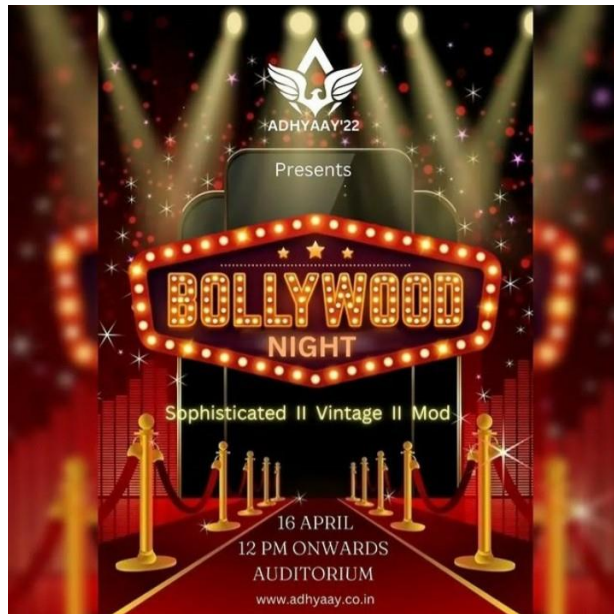

Dance Battle:

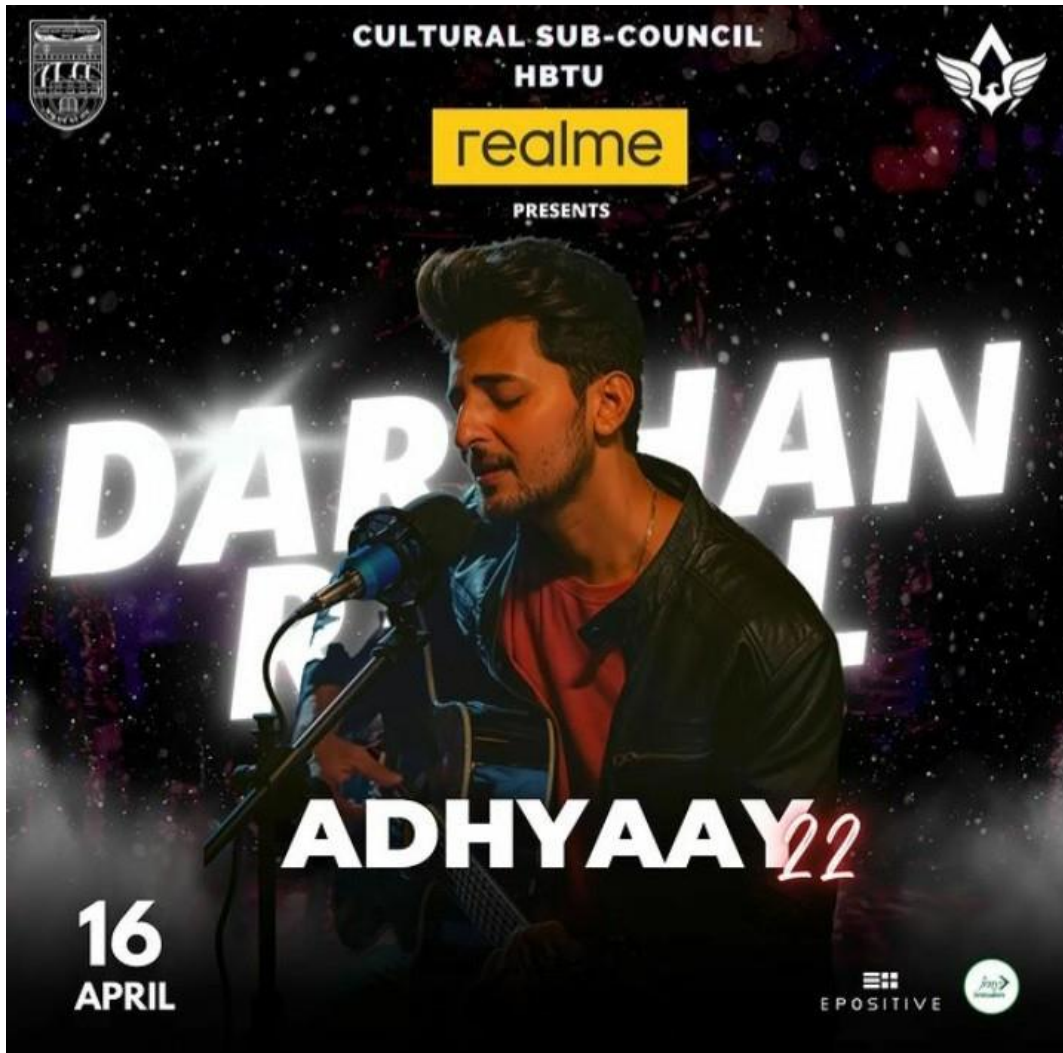
