1.0 Introduction

Harcourt Butler Technical University (Formerly Harcourt Butler Technological Institute, Kanpur) has always been a paragon and a source of inspiration in the field of science and technology since the year 1921. Institute is upgraded to University, i.e., Harcourt Butler Technical University, Kanpur (HBTU, Kanpur) through Government of UP Act. 11 of 2016. The University has been established with a view for making it a leading Residential University to become a “Centre of Excellence” with focus on Research and Development and Incubation in the field of Engineering, Technology, Basic & Applied Sciences, Humanities, Social Science & Management and other professional courses. HBTU, Kanpur aims to promote studies, research & innovation in engineering areas of higher education, to enhance skill development through continuing education programme and to achieve excellence in higher technical education. University has been accredited as A+ University by NAAC in 2023 and 10 courses are NBA accredited.

2.0 HBTU ENDOWMENT FUND (HEF) and It's Guidelines

Higher Education including Technical Education in India is mainly funded by the government through Grant-in-Aid (GIA) or budgetary support. With the expansion of higher education as well as to improve the quality of education through better infrastructure and other facilities the fund requirements in future will increase. The world over, including India, many institutions have established the Corpus Fund to generate funding from sources other than GIA and also to meet the needs of funds by the university.

Therefore, building of a corpus fund is important, in order to ensure smooth sustenance of university. Though, core activities of the university will continue to meet with the help of University Generated Fund and GIA from Government, but creation of corpus fund is envisaged by HBTU Act 2016 for specific purpose and it will be generated from different sources. HBTU Endowment Fund (HEF) may involve contributions from alumni, parents businesses, Corporates, professionals, and friends in building up a strong financial base for the purpose of strengthening infrastructure and extending support to young talents to achieve their dreams without any financial constraints.

2.1 The Executive Council of the University in its 22th meeting held on 25/02/2023 vide Agenda no. 22.08 has approved formation & Constitution of Alumni Cell and open separate Account “Alumni Endowment Fund Account HBTU” for receiving funds from the following sources:

- (a) Alumni, Parent, Society and any individuals
- (b) Industrial/business Houses, Cooperatives, Professional Associations
- (c) Consultancy, Projects, Patents
- (d) Conferences, Seminars, Faculty Development Programs

2.2 Endowment given by donors may be for specific purpose or open donation

2.3 The university may utilize the open donation for the following purposes:

- (a) Construction, Renovation of existing buildings and landscaping.
- (b) Purchase of equipment, books, journals etc.
- (c) Enhancing facilities for students and staff
- (d) Establishment & Modernization of laboratories and research centers
- (e) Funding research projects patents, innovation, incubation, entrepreneurship and research centers etc.

2.4 Specific purpose donations may as below but not limited to

- (a) Establishment of Chairs
- (b) Student support
 - i. For meritorious students for innovative entrepreneurship
 - ii. For research and higher studies
 - iii. For innovative projects

- iv. For enhancing incubation facility
- v. For Research and/or Teaching Assistantship
- vi. Financial help to needy students for continuance of study at HBTU Kanpur on recommendation of a committee consisting of Dean P&RG

(c) Specific scholarship like

- i. Overall topper in the University
- ii. Overall topper of a particular year/semester
- iii. Topper of a branch overall
- iv. Topper of a branch in a particular year
- v. Topper of a particular subject/ project/ industrial training
- vi. Best sports person Male/Female
- vii. It could be also for a particular category of student viz. general/ reserved/ PWD

Duration of scholarship	5 Years
Minimum amount	1,20,000/-per year
Amount to be deposited	Full amount of 5 years at the time of start of scholarship (1,20,000 x 5 = 6,00,000/-)
Disbursement	Every month or lump sum depending on students request/Donors consent
Name/Title of the scholarship /condition	The donor should specify the criteria for award in terms of branch, year, means or merit and also give name/title of scholarship.

(d) Medals: medals can also be instituted for the student in the name of passing batch, spouse, and parents for specific purpose. The description of medal is as follows:

- i. Medal shall be preferably of 100 gms silver with gold plating.
- ii. The medal shall have HBTU logo on one side and donor's inscription on the reverse side.
- iii. The medalist shall receive medal and citation at the time of convocation or any date decided by the university along with a cash incentive of Rs. 40,000.00
- iv. Minimum duration for medal is 10 years, Amount to be deposited is Rs. 5.00 Lacs
- v. One medal with cash of Rs. 40000.00 will cost about Rs. 50000.00, accordingly i. to iv. shall be adjusted.

(e) Any other purpose in the interest of University with the approval of Executive Council.

(f) A wall of Donor shall be made in University Website.

3.0 Important Note

- **Donors are eligible for exemption under section 80G of Income Tax.**
